Attorneys/Title Examiners/General Public:

- We look forward to seeing you, however, due to the volume of business and our present staffing levels we would encourage attorneys to continue to e-file.
- A queue system will be in place for in-person recordings integrated with e-file submissions. In other words, if there are 10 e-file submissions in the queue when you arrive to record you will be #11 in the queue for recording. At busy times the queue will also apply for copy purchases and general information requests.
- Land Court filings need to be in the queue by 3:30 pm. If your documents are determined to be non-recordable as presented, you will have to reenter the queue.
- Due to the volume of business and our present staffing levels you are urged to submit your recordings (e-file or in-person) to us as early in the day as possible. We would appreciate it greatly if you would limit your non-time sensitive recordings to the morning hours on our busiest days, which are typically Fridays and the first and last business day of the month.
- There are no closing tables available in the building
- Please keep in mind that you are subject to security rules imposed by the Court System when you enter the building.
